Please note this list is entirely reliant on seed collectors notes, I generally do not list any seeds without a specific epithet unless the notes warrant this, I have details if requested. Of the 418 (up from 300 last year – well done to our collectors!) seed donations I have eliminated 25 with either no seed or species, and 57 which were duplicates.

Seed donations, from March to end November 2015, are always welcome as below, in paper envelopes or bags, please not in polythene bags as the seed often rots, and with full plant name please, and name and address of sender.

All seeds are a result of open pollination, there is always a possibility of seedlings not coming true.

Cultivar names are given as guidance of parentage only, please do not distribute under cultivar name.

(P) after name indicates some part of the plant is poisonous or a potential risk, please take care, and notify me of any omissions on my part on this.

I have tried to follow the names as per Plant Finder, some are only listed in a few nurseries if at all, and I have added synonyms/old names where appropriate. Errors and omissions are entirely mine – comments welcome at
