DAFFODILS

Narcissus. Amaryllidaceae.

In the following catalogue, I have listed cultivars alphabetically under the separate raisers. I have annotated some of the cultivars, but because details of all the others are available in the International daffodil register (1998), I have omitted descriptions, parentage and awards (except awards of garden merit AGM). I am extremely grateful to the Daffodil Registrar, Sally Kington, for her collaboration, and most especially for providing me with alphabetic lists of cultivars for the raisers.

Origins unknown

'Big Irish Spurius'

name - note that this is probably not a valid cultivar name, but it was a convenient moniker used by daffodil enthusiasts. 'It increases slowly, making bulbs larger than any other trumpet Daffodil, some of the bulbs producing four or five scapes. The flower, though less bright in colour and different in shape, rivals in size those of the true N. maximus.'

Origin: 'Nobody knows its origin ...' - a daffodil that populates the pages of horticultural periodicals in the 1880s, and obviously known from Irish gardens. C. Wolley Dod was one who wrote about it.

With your remark that this Daffodil deserves a better name I quite agree, for it is nearly the finest variety of Narcissus Pseudo-Narcissus in cultivation. ... I first received flowers of it, followed by a hamper of bulbs about seven years ago, from a lady on whose father's land it grew near the river Blackwater, in the county of Cork. It grows there still ... It flowers with me here nearly as early as the Tenby Daffodil, coming out in average season the first week in March ... I do not think the large variety was known in England until I distributed some about five years ago.

'Marie'

'A fine bold' flower 'almost as white as a good cernuus'.

Origin: a spontaneous seedling in a garden in Co. Wicklow, where 'there are many interesting seedlings'. This one was a cross between N. bicolor and N. cernuus (see also 'Rosa'). Frederick Moore wrote that

One of the secrets of these seedlings appearing in this Wicklow garden is the fact that it has always been tended by a lady who loves it, who weeds it herself by hand, and who never allows a scuffle-hoe to be used against her pets.

'Rosa'

White flowers.

Origin: a spontaneous seedling in a garden in Co. Wicklow, where 'there are many interesting seedlings'. This one, 'a cross between N. nanus and N. cernuus'. (see also 'Marie'). ref: Gard chron. 31 (ser. 3) (3 May 1902): 294.

Annesley, Lord: Castlewellan, Co. Down 1 cultivar recorded.

'Countess of Annesley'

'a distinct and beautiful daffodil'; no other description

Origin: 'Castlewellan is the home of a distinct and

beautiful Daffodil which was found naturalized and growing abundantly some years ago, and whence it has been distributed under the name of Countess of Annesley.

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Bucknall, Mrs.: Creagh Castle, Doneraile, Co. Cork.

"Creagh Castle seedling"

'A small yellow self bearing some resemblance to *N. minor*, from which it is probably descended.'

Origin: 'A welcome little Daffodil' from Mrs. Bucknall, who brought it to the fortnightly exhibition at the Royal Horticultural Society, London, on 31 January 1928. 'It was a seedling that had been flowering freely in the open without protection from January 14th. Unfortunately for this seedling it was shown so early in the year that it did not some before the Narcissus

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Carncairn Daffodils - see Reade, Kate

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Currey, Miss Frances ('Fanny') Wilmot: Lismore, Co. Waterford.

7 cultivars recorded.

There is scant information about Fanny Currey in horticultural literature; P. R. Barr noted that she was 'for many years ... a large grower of Daffodils at Lismore ... and exhibited regularly at the Midland Daffodil Show and in

London. She was a woman of many accomplishments, proficient in riding, shooting and fishing, besides being clever with her pencil. She and her life-long friend, Miss Helen O'Hara, were well known figures at the Midland and London Daffodil shows previous to 1910. After a long illness Miss Currey passed away in 1912.' This is not accurate however.

Fanny Currey was born in Lismore in 1848 and died there in 1917.

'Perianth deep primrose colour, cup the most intense orange ... a distinctly shaped flower'.

'The trumpet is cleft into four segments which are very much frilled in the quaintest manner, giving it the appearance of a perfectly double flower: very distinct and quite unique.'

Origin: A seedling raised at Daisy Hill Nursery from 'Cernuus'; a single bulb cost 30 shillings (£1. 10s. 0d.) in 1904.

The garden was on the old palace grounds attached to the See of St Finbarr's and Bishop Mann was the last resident divine, and must have been very fond of flowers. The bulbs were growing in between huge roots of beech, at least 200 years planted, and we had to use a crow-bar and pick-axe to get at them and lost or mangled numbers.'

Origin: Hartland named and introduced this daffodil. It is likely that it was one of the white-flowered daffodils that he had collected in gardens about Cork in the latter quarter of the nineteenth century. Very rare, but still in cultivation. Stocks of this daffodil were damaged in a fire on 17 November 1892 –

a fire, originating in the out-offices at Ard Cairn, Cork, and spreading to the bulb-house ... half of this rare collection of Trumpet White Daffodils has been entirely lost, some very valuable and scarce. One lot of 'Colleen Bawn', probably the most beautiful of all (600 bulbs), just removed from the warehouse for planting, are a great loss.

Can you give me any information about the fine scarlet-cupped incomparabilis of which you brought a drawing to Chiswick 2 years ago [1889], & which I believe was raised by some labyfore 1895 Ireland. Would she allow her name to be known, that I might correspond with her, and is it at all likely that she would sell a bulb, as it is my desire to obtain all the best modern seedlings if possible? — Or possibly she would accept a bulb of my prize seedling 'Albatross' in exchange. But of course I shall understand if she prefers to retain the plant. [G. H. Engleheart to F. W. Burbidge 10 Ostepher 1910 1891]

Undoubtedly the lady was Mrs Lawrenson; the daffodil may well have been 'Lucifer'.

Mrs Lawrenson's identity was not really a secret. In 1896, Burbidge spoke about her directly in his address entitled "The past, present and future of the Narcissus', which opened the 1896 Daffodil Conference.

Then we want colour, tricolours, it may be, instead of bicolours, or at least we want Horsfield's Daffodil with an orange or scarlet trumpet. It is suggestive that our highest coloured kinds, those having red cups, are hybrids of N. poeticus poetarum, with varieties of the Daffodil; – such as N. C. J. Backhouse, N. Mary Anderson, N. Queen Sopha, and various forms of Barri or Burbidgei. The purest and most brilliant varieties yet raised were obtained in Ireland some years ago by Mrs. Lawrenson between N. princeps and N. poetarum, and have crape-like white perianths and scarlet crows, and so far these are the earliest and highest coloured of all the hybrids known to me.

Many people have said to me why sell it to the Dutch who are increasing it very fast and will bring the price down? That pleases me as I would like to see more people enjoying it. It owes me nothing!
